Announcement of 2022 Face-to-Face IEC 61850 IOP

COVID has impacted all of us in myriads of different ways and still continues to do so in 2022. With that said, UCAlug is in the process of executing a two-part IEC 61850 Interoperability Test.

The first part of the test was a successful SCL virtual IOP which occurred the week of November 8-12th,2021. Test results from SCL IOP should be available to UCAlug members prior to June 2022.

The second part is to be an in-person face-to-face IOP. The relevant information is:

Dates: July 14-22, 2022 (setup July 14-17th, July 18-22nd the actual IOP)

Location: CESI: Milan, Italy

Testing of Tools, PTP over PRP, Client/Server, GOOSE/R-GOOSE, SV/R-SV, and Security

Additionally: IEC 61850 for SCADA (Control Center to Substation) with the first ADMS to support IEC

61850.

If you are a utility or consultant, this is the time to bring your issues and concerns to the IOP and have test cases developed to provide coverage for those concerns. The IOPs represent a low cost method to have these concerns investigated in a multi-vendor environment.
